Policy - Use of the Community Hall by Charitable Organizations

For the purpose of this policy, a charitable organization is defined as follows:

- One who charitable event is a service for residents of the Apache Shares community. An example is use of the hall by a Brownie or Boy Scout troop.
- One whose event must benefit the Apache Shores community either directly or indirectly. An example a direct benefit is one that provides goods or services to persons who live in Apache Shores.

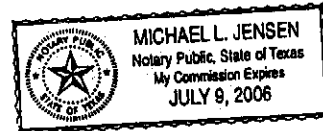
The Board decides which organizations meet the criteria.

- One weekend per charity event per year at no charge. Future events may be scheduled, if the community hall is not already rented, for a minimal donation of twenty five dollars (\$25.00).
- The charity must sign all papers in the community hall usage agreement packet.
- The charity is responsible for a security deposit totaling two hundred fifty dollar (\$250.00) per event and is subject to conditions of the post-event inspection. If an approved event consists of several short-term sequential usages, only one deposit is required.
